- Manage and advise on security budget
- Establish a culture of information protection across the enterprise using tools and frameworks supported by industry standards
- Maintain relationships with local, state and federal law enforcement and other related government agencies
- Establish practices to be used in pursuing and reporting breaches of IT security, working with legal counsel and law enforcement agencies
- Work with IT operations and executive management to safeguard the company's assets such as networks, datacenter white space and general premises, customer facilities, general and customer specific computing fabric and intellectual property
- Work closely with corporate executives, business managers, audit and legal counsel to understand corporate requirements related to security and regulatory compliance, and to map those requirements to current security projects
- Align commercial and business objectives with the security standards of the company, minimizing risk exposure
